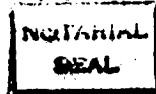

State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, Daniel Clarke of Warren County, Iowa, being sworn depose and say that I am the surviving husband of Ella Clarke who died intestate in Warren County, Iowa, on the 7th day of November, A.D. 1918. That I was perfectly familiar with her business and know that she was not indebted to any one at the time of her death.
