State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, John C. Johnson of said County and State being sworn depose and say that I am a brother of Mary A. Swisher, who was one of the children and heirs at law of Kate Johnson, deceased. That said Mary A. Swisher died in the State of Indiana on October 11th, A.D. 1918. That she died intestate and her estate was fully settled in the State of Indiana. That she was not indebted to any one in this State and no claims were filed against her estate in Indiana.

That I was perfectly familiar with her entire business and know that no claims were filed against her estate. That she had no separate business of her own and nothing that would cause her to contract a general indebtedness, and she had no debts or obligation in the state of Iowa. That she left a husband M. D. Swisher, surviving her and she also left three children to-wit: Robert D. Swisher, Bernard Swisher and Harry Swisher, as her only children and heirs at law and a guardian was appointed for them in this state who obtained an order authorizing him to execute a guardian's deed for them. Which deed has been executed and approved by the court. That all the property the said Mary A. Swisher had in the State of Iowa was her interest in the estate of Kate Johnson, deceased, and that interest has been conveyed to Martin M. Gavin by a Quit Claim deed from her husband and a guardians deed from the guardian of the children as aforesaid.
