

State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, Alva S. Martin, of Madison County, Iowa, being first duly sworn do depose and say, that I am a son of David G. Martin who died on or about October 30th, 1885 seized in fee simple of the North-west One Fourth (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the South East Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Two (2) and commencing at the North west Corner of the South West Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Eleven (11) thence South One Hundred and Twenty (120) rods, thence East Thirty (30) rods, thence North One Hundred and Twenty (120) rods, thence West Thirty (30) rods to the place of beginning, all in Township Seventy five (75) north of Range Twenty eight (28) West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, containing Sixty Two and One-half (62 $\frac{1}{2}$) Acres more or less, and that as such son of said decedent I am well and personally acquainted with H.W. Griffin who is named in the registry of heirs of said deceased, and Henry W. Griffin who is made a party defendant in a certain suit instituted in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, at the May Term, 1892, thereof; and Henry Griffin named in the last will and testament of said deceased which is recorded in will record B on pages 91 and 92 thereof; and Henry W. Griffin on whom notice was served of the pendency of said action, and that they are all the same and identical person; and that Martha S. Stanley who is named in the registry of heirs as above stated died leaving as her only heirs at law John Stanley, Laura Copeland, Michael Stanley, Belle Stanley, Charles Stanley, and--who were made party defendants in the action above described; and that Mary J. Carroll who is named as one of the heirs at law in the registry of heirs above referred to died intestate, leaving as her only heirs at law Kate Carroll, Samuel Carroll, Stella Carroll, and David Carroll, who are made party defendants in the action in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, as above referred to; and that Amelia I. Fenton, who is named in the registry of heirs in the suit of said decedent above referred to, who left as her only heirs at law, Edward Fenton, Charles Fenton, and Arthur Fenton; and that Mrs. D.G. Martin to whom a certain judgment recorded in the office of the Clerk of the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, in Docket 6, on page 234 thereof, is the same and identical person as Emily J. Martin referred to in the registry of heirs of said decedent and is found in record B on page 91 and 92 of the records of said District Court
