State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, G.S. Haynes, being first duly sworn on oath depose and say, that I am the grantee in the Deed Recorded in Deed Record 49, page 302 of the records of Madison Co. Iowa, conveying the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 10, and a tract of land containing 10 acres being 20 rods wide by 80 rods long off the East side of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 9, in Township 75 North, of Range 26, and grantee in Deed recorded in Book 46 page 225 of said records conveying NE Sec 10-75-26 and grantee in Deed recorded in Book 52 page 24 of said records conveying NW NW 10-75-26 and that the personal taxes assessed against G.S. Haynes in South Township for the year 1913 amounting to \$ 2.24 and against the G.S. Haynes in South Township for the year 1914 amounting to \$1.75, and the personal taxes assessed against Sanford Haynes in South Township for the Years 1915 for \$1.45, 1917 for \$3.69, and 1918 for \$ 7.13, and the personal taxes assessed against Sant Haynes in South Township for the year 1919 amounting to \$ 5.50 refer to and are the taxes of another G.S.
