I, W.B.Allen of said State and County first being duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with John R. Kale who died seized in fee of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ (25) & E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 36-75-27 and I well and personally know that he was the same and identical person who purchased said land of Joseph W. McWilliams and to whom said Joseph W. McWilliams and wife conveyed said land on December 9th, 1854 his name being written in said deed John K. Kale by mistake and should have been John R. Kale, and I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with the widow and heirs of John R. Kale and well and personally know that Eliza Kale the widow of said John R. Kale intermarried with one Isaac Allen that Eliza Kale and Eliza Allen are one and the same persons and that to my personal knowledge Elisabeth Jane Oglesbee who was one of the grantors in a deed conveying said land to Isaac N. Landis was the same and identical person as Elisabeth J. Kale who is given in the Registry of heirs filed in the estate of said John R. Kale as one of his heirs, she having intermarried with one John Oglesbee, and that Peree E. Sutton who was also one of the grantors in said deed to Isaac N. Landis was to my personal knowledge the same and identical person as Peree Ellen Kale one of the heirs at law of said John R. Kale, she having intermarried with one Caleb Sutton, and I further depose and say that I well and personally know that Mary A. Landis who joined in a deed with Isaac N. Landis, dated February 2nd, 1870 and conveying the N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 25-75-27 to Caleb Sutton and who joined with said Isaac N. Landis in a deed dated August 14th, 1875 and conveyed the S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ (25) & NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ & N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 36-75-27 to William B. Allen was the same and identical person as Mary A. Kale given as one of the heirs at law of said John R. Kale in the registry of heirs filed in his estate, and I further depose and say that I am well and personally acquainted with William B. Allen who on November 17th, 1896 conveyed the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 25-75--27 and other lands to Thomas J. Allen, Jr., and I well and personally know that he is the same and identical person as William Allen to whom Wm M. Armstrong and wife conveyed the N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 25-75-27 on January 15th, 1875
