State of Iowa County of Madison SS: I, Harry W. Hill, being first duly affirmed, depose and say that I am personally acquainted with John H. Taylor and that he has always lived in Madison Township and Earlham, Iowa, and that the taxes of J. H. Taylor for 1918, St. Charles, Iowa, refers to some other J. H. Taylor and does not refer to John H. Taylor who is the owner of the South Half of the Southwest Quarter and Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 10 and the Northwest Quarter and the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter and the East Half of the East Half of the Southwest Quarter and the West Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 15, all in Township 77, Range 28.

Also that the taxes listed against J. Taylor for the years 1899, 1901, 1902, and 1905 in Penn Township and 1908 in Earlham, Iowa does not refer to John H. Taylor, the owner of the above described land, but does refer to a cousin of John H. Taylor, who lived in Penn Township during the years mentioned and in Earlham, Iowa.
