State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, W.G. Dorrell, of said county and state, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath depose and say that I have been a continuous resident of said county, for more than 74 years, and that the following facts are known to me of my personal knowledge.

That the James S. McCreery, to whom was patented the Southeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of ^{the} Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 22, in Township 74 North, of Range 26, West of the 5th P.M. is the same identical person as the James H. McCreery, who, on January 28th, 1857, conveyed said land to M.S. Douglass, by deed recorded at page 371 of Deed Record F, of the records of Madison County, Iowa.

That the M.S. Douglass above referred to is the same identical person as the M.S. Douglas who, with his wife, Julia A. Douglass, conveyed said land to E.P. Douglass on May 26th, 1857, by deed recorded at page 557 of Deed Record F, of said records.

That the James K.P. Douglas, named as attorney in fact in a certain power of attorney executed by E.P. Douglas and wife, Clementina, dated July 18th, 1857, and recorded at page 318 of Deed Record R, of said records, was the same identical person as the J.K.P. Douglass, who, as such attorney in fact for the said E.P. Douglass and wife, conveyed said land to Josephus Low on May 14th, 1859, by deed recorded at page 269 of Deed Record 2, of said records.

That the P.B. Fisk who is named as grantee in a certain warranty deed from John Shippy

Miscellaneous Record, No. 20, Madison County, Iowa.

and wife, dated July 27th, 1876, and recorded at page 389 of Deed Record 12, of said records, is the same and identical person as the Pliny B. Fisk, who with his wife, Jane A. Conveyed said land to Isaac Miller, by deed dated January 8th, 1881, and recorded at page 312, of Deed Record 19, of said records.

That the Isaac Miller above referred to, is the same and identical person as the I. N. Miller, who, with his wife, Lizzie, conveyed said land to Joseph H. Creger, by deed dated September 28th, 1882, and recorded at page 367 of Deed Record 20, of said records.

That the Joseph H. Creger above referred to, is the same and identical person as the J. H. Creger, who, with his wife Elizabeth conveyed said land to A. L. Creger, by deed dated April 18th, 1887, and recorded at page 389 of Deed Record 26, of said records.

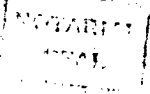
That the T. H. Myers, named as grantee in a certain warranty deed from Rob't Worster, and wife, Cornelia, dated July 20th, 1860, conveying the Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 22, in Township 74 North, of Range 26, West of the 5th. P.M., and recorded at page 560 of Deed Record 1, of said records, is the same and identical person as the Theodore H. Myers, who with his wife, Elizabeth R., conveyed said land to Cornelia D. Worster by deed dated November 7th, 1864, and recorded at page 256 of Deed Record 0 of said records.

That the Samuel J. Work who is named as grantee in a certain deed from Cornelia D. Worster and husband, Rob't, conveying said land last above described, and recorded at page 612, of Deed Record 3, of said records, is the same identical person as the S. J. Work, who, with his wife, Mary A., conveyed said land to Herman Englebach by deed dated October, 5th, 1869, and recorded at page 227 of Deed Record 2, of said records.

That I was well acquainted with said Herman Englebach, who died, intestate, in Clarke County, Iowa, about the year 1881, leaving as his widow, Elisabeth Englebach, and as his sole and only heirs at law, George Englebach, Christene Englebach, Christian Englebach, Henry Englebach, Herman Englebach, Frederick Englebach, and William Englebach, and that the said Herman Englebach left no other heirs either as child of a deceased child or by adoption or otherwise,
