State of Iowa, Madison County SS: I, W.G. Dorrell of said County and State being first duly sworn upon oath depose and say that I am now and have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, since the year 1846, and that from my residence in said County I was acquainted with the early settlers and have knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated.

That William Stackhouse and Martha C. Stackhouse who conveyed the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 28-77-29, Madison County, Iowa, to Joshua Stackhouse by Warranty Deed recorded in Deed Record "O", page 610 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, were husband and wife, on the date of said conveyance, to-wit: February 1, 1858, and that said Martha C. Stackhouse who signed said deed was the same and identical person as Martha named in the conveying clause and certificate of acknowledgment attached to said deed, and referred to Martha C. Stackhouse, the wife of said William Stackhouse.

That Joshua Stackhouse and Ellen J. Stackhouse who conveyed said land to William Baker by Warranty Deed recorded in Deed Record "O", page 611 of said records, were husband and wife on the date of said conveyance, to-wit: October 5, 1864, and that said Ellen J. Stackhouse who signed said deed and Ellen Jane Stackhouse named in the conveying clause and certificate of acknowledgment attached to said deed was the same and identical person.

That William Young and Martha Young who conveyed the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 28-77-29 to Jacob Bricker by Warranty Deed recorded in Deed Record 18, page 247 of said records, were husband and wife, on the date of said conveyance, to-wit: December 16, 1879, and that said Martha Young who signed said deed was the same and identical person as the Martha Young named in the conveying clause in said deed, and her name only appears in said conveying clause as Martha Youn\_ by error on the part of the party who drew said deed.

I further state that I am in no way interested in the title to said land, but make this affidavit at the request of the present owners thereof for the purpose of establishing of record the facts as herein stated.
