Colver who received from Wm. Compton and wife the deed recorded in deed record one page 326 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, for the East 1/2 of Lot 6 in Hutching's Addition To Winterset, Madison County, Iowa.. And that the Charles C. Colver who was named as Grantee in said deed is the same identical person as the Charles C. Clover named in said deed. That his true name was Charles C. Colver and the name Clover is simply a clerical error in said deed. That I was also well and intimately acquainted with H.A. Negus and O.W. Negus who are named as Grantors in a deed dated March 15th, 1882, for the property above described recorded in Town Lot Deed Record 5 page 140 and I know that they were husband and wife on March 15th, 1882 when they executed said deed.

That I have no interest whatever in this matter and simply make this affidavit for the purpose of correcting defects in the title.
