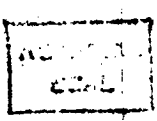

State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, Daniel McConnelee of said State and County first being duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I am a son and heir at law of William McConnelee, deceased, and I well and personally know that the said William McConnelee died in Madison county, Iowa, intestate, on or about Feb. 12th, 1880 leaving surviving him as his widow Margaret McConnelee, and as his sole and only heirs at law his children James McConnelee, W. J. McConnelee, S. J. McConnelee, A. J. McConnelee, Ann M. Herring and Archibald McConnelee, and I further depose and say that the estate of the said William McConnelee was never administered upon but that his estate has long since been fully settled and all claims paid in full, and I further depose and say that S. J. McConnelee one of the children and heirs at law of said William McConnelee, deceased, was the same and identical person as Sarah J. McConnelee, who was one of the defendants in an action in the District Court of Madison county, Iowa, quieting the title to land in Sec 3-75-27, wherein George J. Breeding for the use of W. H. Wright was plaintiff and Woodward Worl et al were defendants, and that the said S. J. McConnelee was the same and identical person as Sarah J. McConnelee who accepted service of the original notice in said action, and I further depose and say that Margaret McConnelee, W. J. McConnelee and Ann M. Herring were not residents of the State of Iowa during the entire years of 1894 and 1895.
