Cooper of said County and State, on oath say that I have been acquainted with the possession and occupancy of the North Half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-six (26), in Township Seventy-six (76) North, of Range Twenty-eight (28), West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, for more than twenty-five years last past; that I know of my own personal knowledge that George A. Tullis owned said land and was in the possession and occupancy of it for many years prior to the year 1897, when he sold and conveyed the same unto one Hannah W. Moore, and that said Hannah W. Moore remained in possession of the same until the conveyance by the Sheriff of Madison County, Iowa, to one C. Danforth, on or about the 5th day of April, 1899, and that said C. Danforth remained in possession and occupancy of said real estate until he sold and conveyed the same unto George B. Dolson, whose name is some times spelled "Dalsen", in April, 1900, and that said George B. Dolson remained in the possession and occupancy of said real estate until he sold and conveyed the same unto W.F. Hudson on February 27, 1918.

That I have known all of said parties and know that no person other than said parties during said period ever asserted any right, title or interest in or to said real estate, or any part thereof, or made or asserted any claim to the possession or right to the possession of any part of said real estate.
