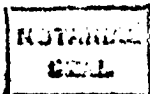

State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, S.W. Stark, of said County and State, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath, depose and say: That I am the same identical person as the S.W. Stark named as grantee in a deed from Lida Danforth and husband, dated May 14th, 1900, recorded in Deed Record 12 at Page 106, of the deed records of Madison County, Iowa, and named as grantor in a deed to J.A. Binns, dated March 1st, 1911, recorded in Deed Record 16, at Page 511 of the Deed Records of Madison County, Iowa, and both of which deeds convey Lot 2 in Block 3 in Danforth's Addition to Winterset, Iowa; that the F.B. Stark, named as one of the grantees in the first above described deed and the Florence B. Stark named as one of the grantors in the last above described deed, was one and the same identical person, she being my then wife; that I was personally and well acquainted with the J.A. Binns named as grantee in the deed last above described, and know of my own personal knowledge that he was the same identical person as the James A. Binns, named as grantor in the deed conveying the said premises to John Hamilton and which is dated September 16th, 1913, and recorded in Deed Record 19 at Page 107 of the Deed Records of Madison County, Iowa; that all the above statements are made from personal knowledge and that I have no interest in making this affidavit except to establish the facts herein set forth and this affidavit is made at the request of the present owner of said premises for the purpose of being recorded and removing a cloud from the title thereof. Further deponent sayeth not.
