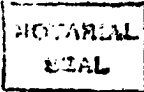
State of Iowa, Madison County SS:

I, E. J. Spurgin of said County and State being first duly sworn, upon oath depose and say that I have been a resident of Ohio Township, Madison County Iowa, for 40 years last past; that I was well and personally acquainted with Wesley J. Stalcup who at one time owned the East 5 acres of the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 34-74-26, and other land, acquiring title thereto and recorded in Deed Record "M", page 182 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and who, with his wife joining conveyed said 5 acres to John Shippy by deed recorded in Deed Record "K", page 571 of said records; that said Wesley J. Stalcup's name as written in the Conveying Clause of said deed to him appears as "J Stalcup and Wesley", and that such arrangement of his name as stated above in the Conveying Clause of said deed was only made by clerical error on the part of the Recorder, and should have recited "Wesley J. Stalcup" as his name appears in the other places in the deed, and the Certificate of Acknowledgment attached thereto.

I further state that I have no interest in the title to the land described above, but make this affidavit at the request of the present owner, for the purpose of establishing of record the facts as herein stated.
