Bird, of said state and county, being first duly sworn, upon my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Frances Sawyer, who was the grantee in a deed from John McCartney, dated April 12th, 1856, conveying SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 20-75-27 Madison county, Iowa, and well and personally know that he is the same and identical person as Francis C. Sawyer, this grantor in a deed of said land to Anna Debusk, as shown by the records of Madison county, Iowa, on deed record page 364; I further depose and say that said Francis C. Sawyer was an unmarried man at the date of his conveyance of said land as aforesaid. I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Anna Debusk and with her heirs, and that I well and personally know that Henry Rogers and Eunice Rogers were husband and wife, and the Levi Debusk and Eunice A. Debusk were husband and wife, and that James H. Debusk was an unmarried man competent to convey, on March, 15th, 1869, that being the date of a deed from last mentioned parties to August Hoppner, of their $\frac{3}{8}$ th interest in said land. I am in no way interested, and make the above statements from personal knowledge of the facts stated. Further deponent saith not.
