State of Iowa, Madison County SS: I, M.L. Billiman, of said county and state being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath, depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with E.M. Greenway Junior, to whom was patented by the United States Government the Northeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Nineteen (19) in Township Seventy-five (75) North, of Range Twenty six (26) West of the 5th P.M. as shown by copy of patent recorded on page 283 of Deed Record 44 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and personally know that he was the same and identical person as the Edward M. Greenway Jr who is named as grantor in a deed recorded on page 626 of Deed Record "A" of the records of said county and conveying said land to Norvell S. Alcock.

That I was also well and personally acquainted with Wm. H. McClelland and wife Eliza McClelland who are named as grantors in a certain deed recorded on page 475 of Deed Record 10 of the records of said county conveying the undivided one-half interest in the South Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty (20) in Township Seventy five (75) North, of Range Twenty six (26) West of the 5th P.M. to John L. McClelland; that as said deed appears of record the said Eliza McClelland does not appear to have acknowledged the instrument, but that she did, in fact, acknowledge said instrument and the omission of so showing in the deed was a clerical error or mistake of the scrivener in drawing said deed.

Arnold who with his wife joining, conveyed said land to Eli Arnold as shown by deed recorded on page 326 of Deed Record 33 of the records of said county.
