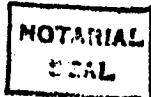

State of Iowa Madison County SS; I, Lyde Emerson, a resident of said county and state, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I am the widow of James Emerson, who died, intestate, in Madison county, Iowa, on or about September 17th, 1915, and that I was the administratrix of the estate of said decedent and as such administratrix filed in said estate a verified registry of heirs of the said decedent, giving a full list of the heirs at law of said decedent, with their correct names.

That on or about September 27th, 1916, I filed in said estate a petition for the admeasurement and setting off to me of my dower interest in the real estate of said decedent, and in such proceedings some of the names of the heirs at law of said decedent are at variance with the said registry of heirs filed by me in said estate as above referred to, but all such variations are mere clerical errors. That is to say, Adda Kelley or Addy Kelly, mentioned in such proceedings for admeasurement of dower is the same person as Adda Kelly, as given in said registry of heirs, the latter being her correct name. And Deriss Emerson or Duress Emerson, and Buelah Emerson or Bulah Emerson, mentioned in such proceedings for the admeasurement of dower, are respectively the same and identical person as Derias Emerson and Baulah Emerson, as their names appear in said registry of heirs the latter being the correct spelling of their names.
