I, Dominic Melroy, of Madison County, Iowa, on oath say that I am a son of Thomas Melroy who died testate in Madison County, Iowa, on or about the twenty ninth day of January, A.D. 1893; that the spelling of his name Thomas Mulroy is a clerical error, and that Thomas Mulroy and Thomas Melroy was one and the same man; that I am the person named a Dominic Melroy in the registry of heirs of said Thomas Melroy, and as the name appears in his last will and testament and also as Thomas Milroy as his name appears in same deed, That my mother Margaret Melroy died in Madison County, Iowa, on or about the tenth day of October, A.D. 1920 that the said Margaret Melroy accepted the provisions of said will of said Thomas Melroy made for her in lieu of dower, and used and occupied all of the real estate of which said <sup>Thomas</sup> Melroy died seized during her life time, and never at any other time made or asserted any other claim thereto than the right to the use and occupancy of the same during her life time That since the year 1899 Thomas Carlinger never was in possession of said real estate of which said Thomas Melroy died seized nor any part thereof, and never made any claim of right to any part of the same, and neither did Talmadge E. Brown or William McConilee, but that at all times since <sup>said year</sup> said Margaret Melroy has been in possession of all of the real estate of which said Thomas Melroy died seized, as life tenant thereof.
