McCall, being a resident of said county and state, and being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Joseph Hamblin, grantee, in a deed from John W. Thompson and Georgia A. Thompson, dated April 24th, 1872, conveying the SW $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. 17-74-28, and I well and personally know that he is the same and identical person as Josephus Hamblin, who with his wife, Rachel E., conveyed said land to John Coakley by deed dated May 23rd, 1873.

That I am also well and personally acquainted with Andrew W. Crawford, grantee in a deed from Charles Polk, dated July 5th, 1895, conveying the SE $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. 8-74-28 (and other land) and I well and personally know that he is the same and identical person as A.W. Crawford, who with his wife Martha A., conveyed said land to Gale McCall by deed dated April 10th, 1907, the land in said last mentioned conveyance being described as the E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. 8-74-28.

Richmond, dated March 23rd, 1866, conveying a tract of land, commencing at the Southeast corner of the SE $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. 8-74-28, running thence North 10 rods, thence West 80 rod, thence South 10 rods, thence East 80 rods to the place of beginning, and I well and personally know that he is the same and identical person, as B.L. Bivin, who died, intestate in Madison county,

Iowa, on or about September 14th, 1875, and whose estate was settled in the probate court of Madison county, Iowa, his widow, Lovey Bivin, being the administratrix.

That I was well and personally acquainted with Manville Bullock, who died intestate in Madison county, Iowa, on or about June 13th, 1900, and whose estate was settled in the probate court of Madison county, Iowa, his son Elbert Bullock being the administrator of said estate, and the said Elbert Bullock being the sole and only heir at law of the said Manville Bullock, who left a widow surviving him.

That I was well and personally acquainted with W.E. Berry, grantee in a deed from Elbert Bullock and wife Lucy B., dated May 6th, 1902, conveying the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 16-74-28, and I well and personally know that he is the same and identical person as William E. Berry, who with his wife Vernie, conveyed said last described real estate to Joseph H. Berry by deed dated January 29th, 1907.
