I further state that I am well acquainted with the persons hereinafter named, and have personal knowledge of the facts hereinafter set forth.

That Wm. H. Norris named in the Beneficiaries and real property Report filed in the Estate of John Norris, deceased, was the same and identical person as the William H. Norris who signed the receipt for his share in the Estate of said decedent, and the same and identical person as the William H. Norris named in the caption of the petition for partition filed in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, March 4, 1904 by Caroline M. Norris, and docketed in Appearance Docket "S", page 132 and the same and identical person as the W. H. Norris named in the Supplemental Decree entered in said cause December 22, 1904. In other words wherever the names Wm. H. Norris, William H. Norris, and W. H. Norris appear in the proceedings had in connection with the Estate of said John Norris, or in connection with the title to the property hereinafter described they in each and every instance refer to one, the same and identical person, William H. Norris.
