I, Clarence Thornburg, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I am a son of William Thornburg to whom his wife, Elizabeth Thornburg, conveyed the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 15-75-28 by deed recorded in Town Lot Deed Record 19, page 3, and who subsequently conveyed said land to Ada B. Hill and Wilbur Hill by deed recorded in Deed Record 46, page 555, That the full name of the said William Thornburg was William M. Thornburg; that he never lived in either Ohio or Monroe Township, in Madison County, Iowa, nor had any property assessed to him in either of said townships; and that the personal tax charged against Wm C. Thornburg in said Ohio Township for the year 1891, and the personal tax charged against Wm. C. Thornburg in said Monroe Township for the year 1892, as shown by the Delinquent Personal Tax Register in the office of the Treasurer of Madison County, Iowa, was levied and charged against some person other than my father, the said William Thornburg, or William M.
