Kale, who died seized of Block 11 & 12 in the Town of Peru, Iowa; that the said R.A. Kale left surviving him his widow, Susannah Kale, and the following named children and grand children as his sole and only heirs at law, to-wit; Caroline McGee, intermarried with M.M. McGee; Hannie Dunlap, this affiant intermarried with A. Dunlap; Ella Petersen, intermarried with Chas. Petersen, Wilson Kale; Orinda A. Young, intermarried with Charles W. Young, Alfred Kale, intermarried with Sarah E. Kale; Thos. Kale intermarried with Catherine Kale; Mary Kirk, intermarried with Charlie Kirk, and Elizabeth Kirk, intermarried with J.W. Kirk.

I further depose and say that the above named Mary Kirk, died prior to November 22nd 1887 leaving surviving her, her husband, the above named Charlie Kirk and as her only children and heirs at law, Retta Seals, intermarried with A.C. Seals, and Ida M. Kirk; and that the above named Elizabeth Kirk died prior to December 13th 1887, leaving surviving her, her husband, the above named J.W. 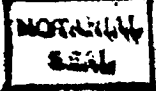
