State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, John Bell being first duly sworn on oath say that according to the County Treasurer's Delinquent Tax Book per assessment roll 1895 the Geo. W. Bell to whom \$2.50 taxes was assessed in 1895 at Patterson was at that time put down in said book as 28 years old. I further state that there was a man by the name of Geo. W. Bell living at Patterson who was no relationship to me. I further state that my brother Geo. W. Bell was born in the year 1852 and in 1895 was therefore 43 years old, and that at no time between the years 1886 and 1895 was my brother a resident of the town of Patterson or of the Township of Crawford in Madison County.

I therefore state that the personal taxes set out at #27 of abstract #14468 prepared by the Security Loan & Title Company of Winterset, Iowa; to wit:-
