State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, Lewis Aikin, of said State and County first being duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I am well and personally acquainted with Hugh McLarnand who together with his wife conveyed to J.F. McLarnand the following described tract of land:- Commencing at the North West corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  9-74 28, running thence South to the SW corner of said 40 acre tract, thence East to the S.E. corner thereof, thence North West to the place of beginning and I well and personally know that he was the same and identical person <sup>as</sup> H. McLarnand to whom said land was conveyed by the Sheriff of Madison county, Iowa, and I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Martin Blohm and with his family and I well and personally know that the said Martin Blohm was an unmarried man at the time of his death and that Caroline A. Aikin, A.L. Blohm, Geo A. Blohm, Mathias A. Blohm, Anton C. Blohm, Martin A. Blohm, Herman J. Blohm, John V. Blohm and Mary A. Reynolds were his sole and only heirs at law and that they were the same and identical persons given in the registry of heirs filed in the estate of said Martin Blohm, deceased, as his only heirs, and I further depose and say that Mary A. Reynolds who joined with her husband John M. Reynolds in a deed conveyed ing the E $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  & SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  9-74-28 to me was a daughter and heir at law of said Martin Blohm deceased, and the same and identical person as May A. Reynolds whose name appears in the registry of heirs filed in the estate of said Martin Blohm as one of his heirs, and I further depose and say that John Walton and Mary Walton were both alive and non-residents of the State of Iowa on October 11th, 1908, that being the date of a decree rendered in the District Court of Madison county, Iowa, in a certain quiet title action wherein John F. McLarnand was plaintiff and Charley Fisher, et al were defendants, the said John Walton and Mary Walton being two of the defendants, in said action.
