Major, of said State and County first being duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with John Lane who entered the Fr'1 N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 1-77-26 and to whom the same was patented and well and personally know that he is the same and identical person as John Law afterwards with Julia Law conveyed the said land by warranty deed dated April 18th, 1855 to Allen Major, his true name being John Lane, and I further depose and say that I well and personally know that the said John Law and Julia Law were husband and wife on the date of said conveyance; and I further depose and say that my father, Allen Major, died intestate on December 12th, 1882 seized in fee of the SW Fr'1 $\frac{1}{4}$ 1-77-26, leaving as his widow, Frances Major, and as his children and only heirs at law, Mary J. Duffy, J.C. Major, Margaret L. Dooley and George F. Major, and that his estate has been long since fully settled and all debts paid.
