Diggs, Grantor in a certain Deed recorded in Deed Record 38 Page 553 of the Madison County, Iowa Record was my brother, and I was well and personally acquainted with the fact that he deeded the following tract of land to J.F. Eisele, to-wit: All the land lying South of the right of way of the Chicago Rock Island and Pacific Railroad, of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 5 in Township 77 North, Range 28, West 5th P.M.
