Johnston of St. Charles, Madison County, Iowa, first being duly sworn do depose and say that I have lived in South Township and St. Charles since the year 1853, and have lived continually in St. Charles ^{since} about the year 1875, and I am well acquainted with the location of Clanton's Addition of 1888 to the Town of St. Charles, Iowa and I was well and personally acquainted with Joel M. Clanton and wife who platted said Addition mentioned above, as shown by a certificate of the surveyor which is recorded in Town Lot Deed Record 4 page 197 thereof of Madison County, Iowa.

That I was a purchaser of the first lots in said Addition, and I am well satisfied that it was the intention of the said Joel M. Clanton to dedicate all the street and alleys in said addition to the public, but by the oversight of the Town officials, or some other person, it was not done. That the streets surrounding Block Three (3) of said Addition have been open and used by the public for nearly thirty years.
