State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, M.L. Silliman, of said county and state, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with the E.W. Harrell, who died seized of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 19; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ & NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 30-75-27; ~~and~~ that the said E.W. Harrell died intestate on or about October 26th, 1914, in Madison County, Iowa, but his estate was never probated; that he left no widow surviving him and as his only children and heirs at law, his son, Edgar Harrell, who is named as grantee in a certain deed recorded at page 129 of Deed Record 58, of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and his daughter, Elvira Holmes (intermarried with one J.W. Holmes), who is named as grantor in the foregoing described deed; that all debts and claims against said estate were fully paid and said estate fully and finally settled.

That the said E.W. Harrell was the same and identical person as the Edmund W. Harrell who is named as grantee in a certain deed from M.W. Peach and wife, recorded at page 39 of Deed Record 4 of said record, and conveying the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 19-75-27; ~~and~~ that he was the same and identical person as the Edmund Watkins Harrell to whom was patented the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 30-75-27 by the United States Government as shown by the records of said county; that he was the same and identical person as the Edmund W. Harrell named as grantee in a certain deed from Susan Ackelsen and others, recorded at page 526 of Deed Record 11, of said records and as the E.W. Harrell named as grantee in a certain deed from Thomas Bardrick and others, recorded at page 490 of Deed Record 20, of said records.

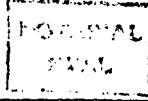
That I have no interest to serve in making this affidavit, other than to establish of record the facts as hereinbefore set forth, which is done at the request of the present owner of said above described real estate.
