Christensen and Gertrude B., his wife did on the 18th day of July 1911. execute and deliver to Bankers Life Association a certain mortgage which was recorded in book 53 on page 446 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, to secure the payment of a certain note for \$5000.00 and interest; now O.O. Conley and Mae Conley, wife the present owner of the premises described in said mortgage, and the Bankers Life Company the present owner of said note and mortgage, do by these presents agree that the principal sum due ^{thereon} is Five Thousand Dollars, and that the same shall bear interest at the rate of 6½ per cent per annum, from August 1, 1921, payable semi-annually, on the first days of February and August of each year and that the principal sum shall become due on the first day of August 1926, at which time the said O.O. Conley hereby assumes and agrees to pay the same with interest at the office of the Bankers Life Company Des Moines, Iowa.

It is further agreed that all the terms, conditions and stipulations contained in said note and mortgage shall continue in full force and effect excepting only as modified by this agreement.

The option in the original note is waived.
