KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Lawrence A. Pinckney and Mae Pinckney Husband and Wife, of Madison County, State of Iowa, in consideration of One Thousand -no/100 Dollars in hand paid by The Trustees of the Macksburg Methodist Episcopal Church of Madison County, State of Iowa do hereby Sell and Convey unto the said <sup>The</sup> Trustees of the Macksburg Methodist Episcopal Church the following described real estate situated in Madison County, State of Iowa to-wit:

The West one half (1/2) of the North East Quarter (1/4) of Section Twelve (12) Township Seventy four (74) North, Range Twenty nine (29) West of the Fifth P.M. of Iowa

Section -- Township-- North, Range-- West 5th P.M., Containing 80 acres.

And we hereby covenant that we lawfully seized of said premises; that they are Free From Incumbrance .

That we have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same; and do hereby covenant to Warrant and Defend the said premises, and appurtenances thereto belonging against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.

And the said May Pinckney hereby relinquishes all right of dower in and to the above described premises.

Provided always, that these presents are upon the express condition, that if said Lawrence Pinckney his heirs, executors, or administrators, shall pay or cause to be paid to the said The Trustees of the Macksburg Methodist Episcopal Church their heirs, executors administrators or assigns, the sum of One Thousand- no/100 Dollars as follows, to-wit:  
One Thousand Dollars, Payable---- 1926.

With interest on all of said sums at the rate of 5 1/2 per cent per annum, until paid, payable annually, according to the tenor and effect of One promissory note of the said Lawrence A. Pinckney payable to The Trustees of the Macksburg Methodist Episcopal Church bearing date July 9, A.D. 1921, then these presents to be void; otherwise to remain in full force.

It is expressly understood that the Mortgagor shall keep all buildings on said premises insured for two-thirds their value in a responsible company for the benefit of the Mortgagee, and shall pay all taxes and assessments on said premises before they become delinquent and failing so to do, the Mortgagee may effect such insurance and pay such taxes

and assessments, and this Mortgage shall stand as security for said amounts so paid with eight per cent interest thereon.

And it is further agreed that if default shall be made in the payment of said sums of money or any part thereof, principal or interest, for the space of thirty days after the same becomes due and payable, or if the taxes assessed upon the above described real estate shall become delinquent, then the whole indebtedness shall become due, and the said Mortgagee, or his legal representatives or assigns, may proceed by foreclosure, or in any other lawful mode, to make the amount of said notes together with all interest and costs, the expense of an abstract of title to said premises up-to-date of foreclosure, and all taxes and assessments accrued on said premises together with a reasonable fee for the plaintiff's attorney out of said real estate.
