State of Iowa, Madison County SS: I, W.P. Love of said County and State being first duly sworn upon oath depose and say that I am now past 68 years of age, and that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for 58 year- last past.

That I was acquainted with Elihu G. Barker, one of the grantors in the Quit Claim Deed recorded in Deed Record "P", page 261 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and who is also named as grantor in the Warranty Deed recorded in Deed Record "S", page 490 of said records, and who is also named as one of the grantors in the Quit Claim Deed recorded in Deed Record 34, page 374 of said records, which deeds were dated December 29, 1864, January 7, 1867 and December 19, 1864, respectively, and I do state that said Elihu G. Barker was a single and unmarried man upon the date of the execution of each of said deeds.

That I was acquainted with Thomas C. Barker and Jeremiah C. Barker who joined in the execution of the Quit Claim Deed recorded in Deed Record "P", page 261 of Madison County, Iowa, records, and that if the name J. C. Barker is shown of record to be signed to said deed twice, the same is an error in the recording of the deed, and that one of the grantors who, as shown by the record of said deed, signed the same as J. C. Barker was in fact T. C. Barker whose full name was Thomas C. Barker above named.

I further state that I am in no way interested in the title to the land affected hereby, but make this affidavit for the purpose of establishing of record the facts herein stated.
