Benson, being duly sworn, depose and on oath say: That I was well and personally acquainted with Challen Danforth, for more than forty years prior to his death on August 10, 1915; that C. Danforth the grantee in a deed of conveyance from Marian A. Hatch and wife Mamie, Lucy A. Titcomb (formally Lucy A. Boyle) widow, dated December 3rd, 1892, wherein was conveyed the undivided two-thirds of Lots 2, 3, and 4 of Block 3 in Original Plat of Winterset, Iowa, and Challen Danforth, the grantee in a deed of conveyance from Eunice E. Low, formally Hatch, and E. H. Low, dated March, 1, 1893, wherein was conveyed the undivided one-third of the same property above described, are one and the same person, to-wit; Challen Danforth; that the said Challen Danforth, named in said deeds as C. Danforth and Challen Danforth is the same and identical person whose whose will was admitted to probate in Madison County, Iowa, on October 6th, 1915, and recorded in Will Record Book on page 28 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, said will being executed and probated under the name C. Danforth.
