Smith who died in Madison County, Iowa, on or about April 15th, 1879, owning the east forty two (42) feet of lot three (3) in block twenty four (24), in the original plat of Winterset, Iowa. that Henry A. Smith and Sylvia Grace Smith named in the registry of heirs of said Alden B. Smith are the same persons as H. A. Smith and S. Grace Smith grantors in a conveyance of said real estate to S. J. Smith dated on or about July 22nd, 1886; that Julia E. Smith named in the registry of heirs of said Alden B. Smith is the same and identical person as Julia Ethel Smith who conveyed said real estate to Sylvia J. Smith on or about December 14th, 1896; that S. J. Smith named as grantee in the first conveyance above referred to, and S. J. Smith grantee in a conveyance of the same real estate from myself and Elsie L. Smith dated on or about September 21st, 1894, and Sylvia J. Smith grantee in the conveyance from Julia Ethel Smith above referred to was the same person, the widow of said Alden B. Smith; that my sister Jennie M. Smith died intestate, unmarried, and without issue on or about the---- day of September A. D. 1884, leaving surviving as her only heir at law her mother, said Sylvia J. Smith; that the estate of said Jennie M. Smith was long since settled, and all indebtedness, if any, paid.
