We, the undersigned, for the purpose of creating an organization under and by virtue of the Laws of the State of Iowa have associated ourselves together and have adopted the following Articles of Incorporation.

Article 1.

The name of this Corporation shall be the Brigade Head Quarters Company 67th, Infantry Brigade Iowa National Guard. Its principal place of transacting business shall be Winterset, Iowa, and the general nature of the business to be transacted shall be to acquire by purchase or otherwise personal and real property for the use and occupation of said organization, and to enter into written contracts of lease of buildings to be used for Armory purposes and real estate for an outdoor target range, and all other matters of business which might pertain toward conducting, operating and carrying on the business of said company.

Article 2.

The time of the commencement of this corporation shall be the 22nd day of December A.D. 1921, and it shall continue for Twenty Years unless sooner dissolved according to law.

Article 3.

There shall be no capital stock authorized in this organization and each active member of the company shall be considered a stock holder and shall be entitled to all the privileges as such and shall entitle each active member to vote on all matters of business arising in the business meetings of said organization.

Article 4.

The affairs of this Corporation shall be conducted by a Board of Directors, who shall be chosen by the active members thereof at their annual meeting which shall be held on the first Monday of January of each year at Winterset, Iowa, and until the first election of Directors the following named persons shall be the Directors: Captain Merl L. Pindell, First Lieutenant Loyd R. Ballard, First Sergeant Curtis R. Cross, Sergeant Dale Bond, Corporal Lyle G. Ballard, Corporal Phil Konkle, Private Vernon F. Clark.

The Directors shall organize and the Commanding officer of the Company shall at all times be the President and Treasurer of the said Corporation, the second in command shall be the Vice President and the First Sergeant shall be the Secretary of the said Corporation. These officers shall perform the duties usually pertaining to their respective offices, and the President and Secretary shall in the name of the Corporation execute all conveyances, written contracts of lease and other contracts made by it upon the authority of the Directors.

Article 5.

The highest amount of indebtedness to which this corporation is at any time to subject itself is Three Thousand Dollars.

Article 6.

The private property of the active members of this Corporation is to be exempt from corporate debts.

Article 7.

These articles may be amended by a majority vote of all the active members thereof at any annual meeting of said members or at any meeting duly called for that purpose.

Article 8.

Fifteen active members of this organization shall be a quorum for the transaction of any business of the Corporation.
