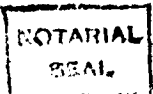
I Harry W. Hill, being first duly affirmed, depose and say that I am well acquainted with the land in Madison County, Iowa, now owned by R.A. Hindman and particularly described as follows, to-wit: All that part of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Nine (9) Township Seventy-seven (77) North, Range Twenty-eight (28) lying east of the railway as now located through the above described quarter. And I personally know that the said R.A. Hindman and his immediate successive grantors in the chain of title have, for more than thirty years last past, been in the actual, open, notorious, ^{continuous} hostile and exclusive adverse possession of said land, and of every part and parcel thereof, under claim of right and color of title, and have, during all of said time, paid all taxes and special assessments levied thereon, and that to my personal knowledge no one ^{has} had or claimed, or is now claiming to have, any right, title of interest in or to said land of any part or parcel thereof, adverse to the right of said R.A. Hindman and his grantors, or been in possession of said lands or any part or parcel thereof. I further say that I am personally acquainted with Louisa K. Maxwell, grantor in certain warranty deed dated July 1, 1899 and recorded in Madison County Deed Record 41, Page 52, conveying the Northwest Quarter of Section 9, Township 77, Range 28. I further state that I am personally acquainted with John S. Williams and Anna C. Williams, grantees in above described deed. I further state

That on date of above described deed the said John S. Williams and Anna G. Williams did take possession of above described land and held full possession of same until they sold it to J.C. Burch on December 14, 1907 and said J.C. Burch held full possession of same until he sold it to Ernest Slavens on May 15, 1908. and that Ernest Slavens held full possession of same until he sold it to Ferd Jensen on January 19, 1914; and that Ferd Jensen held full possession of same until he sold it to C.W. Myers and Grace H. Myers on March 1, 1918; and that C.W. Myers and Grace H. Myers held full possession of same until they sold it to Walter H. Hall on March 1, 1919; and that Walter H. Hall held full possession of same until March 1, 1920-- the time he delivered to E.A. Anderson, and on the same date E.A. Anderson delivered to H.A. Neff and on the same date H.A. Neff delivered to W.W. Clements, and on the same date W.W. Clements delivered it to R.A. Hindman, who holds full undisputed possession at this time. I further state that I am personally acquainted with all the above mentioned parties and have lived continuously in this vicinity for the past forty-three years. I personally know all of the above to be facts to my personal knowledge.
