State of Iowa, Madison County SS: E.B.Hiatt, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that he is the regularly appointed county engineer and surveyor, and that he has duly qualified for the office and has been acting as such engineer and surveyor for the past four years of Madison County, Iowa, That as such county engineer he is conversant with the plats of the railroad right of way through Section 26, Township 76 North, of Range 27 West, in Madison County, Iowa, as the same appear on file in the office of the Auditor of Madison County at Winterset, Iowa; that he has been over the said right of way of the said railroad and knows the location of the said railroad through said section; that the said railroad is known as the Chicago Rock Island and Pacific Railroad, and that the same has heretofore been known and called the Des Moines, Winterset and Southwestern Railroad, and sometimes as in Deed Records of Madison County, book 31 page 116; book 44 page 188; book 47 page 217 and book 48 page 28, it has been called the Des Moines, Winterset and Southern Railroad. That these names refer to the same railroad and right of way, and that there has <sup>never</sup> been but one and the same railroad right of way crossing said Section 26. That the said railroad and right of way thereof enters the Southwest quarter of said section 132 feet south of the northeast corner of the said quarter of said section, and crosses into the south half of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of the said Section 26, and crosses with its center line the west line of said quarter at a point 131 1/2 feet south of the northwest corner of the Southwest quarter of said Section 26 of said Township and Range. That the said railroad right of way lies wholly in the South half of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 26, Township 76 North Range 27 West.
