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Amendment to Articles of Incorporation of Farmers' Mutual Telephone Company of Dexter.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That at the annual meeting of the stock holders of the Farmers' Mutual Telephone Company of Dexter, Iowa, held at its general place of business at Pitzer, Iowa, on the 11th day of September, 1920, at the hour of ten o'clock A.M., the same being the second Saturday of September, 1920, it was moved, seconded, and carried that the name of the Farmers' Mutual Telephone Company of Dexter be changed to the "Farmers' Mutual Telephone Company of Pitzer", so that Article One of the original articles of incorporation will now read as follows;

Article 1.

The name of this Corporation shall be Farmers' Mutual Telephone Company of Pitzer, Iowa, and its principal place of business shall be at Pitzer, in Madison County, Iowa.

It was also moved, seconded, and carried that the day of the annual meeting be changed from the second Saturday of September in each year to the 28th day of December, at ten o'clock A.M., unless the 28th day of December falls on Sunday, then the meeting shall be held on December 27th, so that Article Four of the original articles of incorporation as amended, will read as follows;

Article 1V.

The general affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors consisting of eleven members who shall be elected by the stock holders at the annual meeting which shall be held on the 28th day of December of each year at the hour of ten o'clock A.M., at its general place of business, unless the 28th day of December falls on Sunday, then the meeting shall be held on December 27th.

At the annual meeting of the Farmers' Mutual Telephone Company of Pitzer, Iowa, held at Pitzer, Iowa, on December 28th, 1920, it was moved, seconded, and carried that the President and Secretary be authorized and directed to put in proper form, have approved, recorded and published the changes and amendments made in the First and Fourth of the Original Articles of Incorporation made at the annual meeting on September 11th, 1920.
