State of Iowa, Madison County SS: I, Harry W. Hill being first duly sworn on oath depose and say that I was acquainted with John Williams, Deceased, who died on or about the 11th day of March 1903, seized of the following described real estate, to-wit:

The East Half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section One (1), Township Seventy-seven (77) North, Range Twenty nine (29) west of the fifth P.M. in Madison County, Iowa, as shown by deed recorded in Book 23, Page 575 of the records of Madison County, Iowa; that the said John Williams died intestate leaving no surviving spouse and Belinda Stanley, Wilford Williams, Isaiah Williams, Wm. R. Williams, James Albert Williams, John S. Williams, Thos E. Williams, and Leveretta H. Anderson as his children and all his children and being the sole and only heirs at law of the said John Williams, Deceased; and who are, together with their respective husbands and wives, the grantors in a certain warranty deed conveying the above described real estate as shown by deed recorded in Book 44, page 258 of the records of Madison County, Iowa.

I depose and further state that Wm. R. Williams, son of John Williams, deceased and named in the Registry of heirs, is the same identical person as William R. Williams, one of the grantors in deed recorded in Book 44, Page 258; and the same identical person as W. R. Williams, whose receipt is attached to final report in the estate of John Williams, deceased, and wherever the name Wm. R. Williams, William R. Williams, or W. R. Williams appears in connection to the title to the above described real estate it in each and every instance refers to one and the same person, to-wit: William R. Williams.

I depose and further state that the said Isaiah Williams, one of the heirs at law of said John Williams, deceased and named in the Registry of Heirs, and Isiah Williams in a certain quieting title proceeding wherein Belinda Stanley et al were plaintiffs and William H. Thomas et al were defendants, is one and the same identical person and wherever the name Isaiah Williams or Isiah Williams appears in connection with the title to the above described real estate it in each and every instance refers to one and the same identical person, to-wit: Isaiah Williams.

I depose and further state that James Albert Williams, heir at law of John Williams deceased, and named in the Registry of Heirs, and James A. Williams, one of the grantors in deed recorded in Book 44, Page 258 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and J. A. Williams who executed receipt attached to the final report in the estate of John Williams, deceased, are one and the same identical person and wherever the name James Albert Williams, James A. Williams or J. A. Williams appears in connection to the title to the above described real estate it in each and every instance refers to one and the same identical person, to-wit: James Albert Williams.

I depose and further state that Thos. E. Williams, an heir at law of John Williams, deceased, was not made a party plaintiff in the quieting title proceeding wherein Belinda Stanley et al were plaintiffs and William H. Thomas et al were defendants through inadvertency and mistake, but that the said Thomas E. Williams in fact had an equal share in said property with the plaintiffs therein named and conveyed same by deed recorded in Book 44, Page 258 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, in the name of Thomas E. Williams, and I do state that wherever the name Thos. E. Williams or Thomas E. Williams appears in connection to the title to the above described real estate it in each and every instance refers to one and the same identical person, to-wit: Thomas E. Williams.
