KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Whereas on the 7th, day of April A.D. 1919, Homer G. Tilton and his wife, Blanche L. Tilton executed to W.G. Willows a mortgage upon the South West Quarter of the North East Quarter; and the West Half of the South East Quarter; and the South East Quarter of the North West Quarter; and the East Half of the South West Quarter all in Section 27, Township 74 North, Range 28 West of the 5th, P.M. Iowa, to secure 4 promissory notes aggregating the sum of Thirteen Thousand Dollars.

AND WHEREAS said mortgage has been assigned by W.G. Willows to E.E. McCall as collateral security for a debt of Eight Thousand Four Hundred and Eight Dollars and said mortgage is now held by E.E. McCall as collateral security for said indebtedness.
