IN CONSIDERATION of the terms of the will of Thomas Early, deceased, I do hereby assign and set over unto Laura Wolverton, of the County of Polk and State of Iowa, a certain mortgage executed by C.H. Wicks to Thomas Early, July 5, 1917, covering the Northeast quarter of the north-east quarter of section Eleven (11), township seventy-six (76), north of range twenty-nine (29) west of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Iowa, and the following tract of land;

Commencing twenty (20) rods west of the north-east corner of the south-east quarter of the north-east quarter of section Eleven and running thence west sixty (60) rods; thence south to North River; thence east along the center of the channel of said river to a point twenty (20) rods west of the east line of said forty (40) acre tract; thence north to the place of beginning.

Also ^{commencing} at the north-east corner of the south-east quarter of the north-east quarter of section Eleven; running thence west twenty (20) rods; thence south eight (8) rods; thence east twenty (20) rods; thence north to the place of beginning.

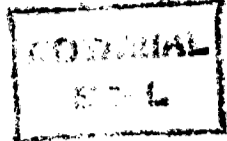
