KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: that we M. J. Roach as principal, and Leo Rose, as sureties, all of the county of Madison and State of Iowa, are held and firmly bound unto J. A. Bates of the county of Madison and State of Iowa, in the sum of Six Hundred & No/100 (\$600.00) Dollars lawful money of the United States of America, well and truly to be paid to the said J. A. Bates, his heirs, executors and assigns.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the said M. J. Roach sold and conveyed to the said J. A. Bates on or about the 2 -- January A. D. 1921, certain real and personally property to wit: a business property in the town of Bevington, Madison County, Iowa, a more particular description thereof being unknown, and a stock of goods and pool and billiard tables and fixtures, and on said property the County of Madison and State of Iowa has levied a mulot tax in the sum of Three Hundred Dollars. Said mulot tax being unlawfully assessed and levied against said property by the County Officials of said County. And said County of Madison through its Officials is threatening to sell said property to satisfy said mulot tax.
