That from my early and continuous residence in said County I was acquainted with nearly all of the early settlers in Madison County, Iowa, and have personal knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated.

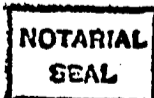
That Nancy Caster who centered and to whom was patented the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 35-77-26 was the same and identical person as Nancy Stuart who with her husband joining executed the conveyance of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 35-77-26 of record in Deed Record "O", page 35 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, she having intermarried with one Stuart prior to the date of execution of said deed and after entering said quarter section; and that said Nancy Caster was the same and identical person as Nancy Curten named in the Conveying Clause of said Deed, and that the writing of the name "Curten" in the record of said deed was apparently an error on the part of the Recorder in recording same and that the name "Caster" was meant.

In other words wherever the names Nancy Caster, Nancy Curten and Nancy Stuart appear in connection with the title to the N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 35-77-26 they refer to one the same and identical person.

I further state that I am in no way interested in the title to the above described land, but make this affidavit at the request of the present owners thereof for the purpose of establishing of record the facts herein stated.
