State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, Jed Osborn, of said county and state, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath depose and say that I am the same and identical person as the Jed Osborn who is named as grantee in a certain warranty deed from Harry E. Holbrook dated April 14th, 1919, and recorded at page 421, of Town Lot Deed Record 22, of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and conveying lots five and six, of Block one, of Bowlsby's Addition to the Town of Winterset, Iowa, and I do state that the judgment in favor of John Catterlin and against J.S. Osborn dated September 30th, 1912, filed for record in the office of the Clerk of the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, on March 8th, 1913, and recorded at page 377 of Judgment Docket 12, of said office, is not a judgment against me, and that the personal tax assessed against one J.E. Osborn for the year 1905, in Madison Township, in said county, for the sum of 50¢, is not assessed against me.
