State of Iowa County of Madison SS: I, Harry W. Hill, being first duly affirmed, depose and say that I have been a continuous resident of Madison County, Iowa, for over forty years, and that I am personally acquainted with Sylvanus Marion Compton, who held power of attorney from his brothers- Stephen Compton, Henry Everett Compton, Milton Wilson Compton, William Lenard Compton, Albert Elwood Compton and Paris B. Compton which power of attorney is recorded in Madison County Miscellaneous Record 18, page 358, and that on June 2, 1915, at the time certain warranty deed was given by Sylvanus Marion Compton, on behalf of himself and his brothers, that said above described power of attorney was not revoked at that time and never has been since.

I further state that all of said brothers are today alive except Milton Wilson Compton, who died several years after the year 1915.

The above is all given from my own personal knowledge as the transaction went through my hands in closing deal between Sylvanus Marion Compton and John H. Taylor.
