State of Iowa, Guthrie County SS; I, Arthur B. Blackman, being first duly sworn on oath depose and say that I am a son of W.E. Blackman, grantee in the warranty deed dated October 13, 1916, recorded July 20, 1917, in Book 58, page 613 of the Deed Records of Madison County, Iowa, wherein there was conveyed to Mary J. Blackman, who was my mother and the wife of W.E. Blackman, the West Half of the Fractional Northeast Quarter, and the Northeast Quarter of the Fractional Northwest Quarter of Section 5, Township 76 North, Range 26 West of the 5th P.M., Madison County, Iowa; that I know of my father's property and know of the value of the same on the 13th day of October, 1916, the date of said deed, and know that at the date of his death on the 28 day of October, 1916, and at the date of said deed, to-wit: October 13, 1916, he did not have property of the value of \$50,000.00 above his debts and liabilities, and that his estate was not subject to the payment of the Federal Estate Tax of the Department of Internal Revenue of the Treasury Department of the Government of the United States. All of which is true, as I verily believe.
