Ringgenberg, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I am the duly appointed and qualified administrator of the estate of William Otto Reinhold, as shown by Probate Docket "H", page 28, and know that the said decedent was the same and identical person as the Wm. Reinhold who acquired title to the N $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{2}$  & NE $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. 29-75-28 by deed recorded in Deed Record 58, page 236; also, that the Louise K. Reinhold who is named in the Registry of Heirs filed in his estate as the widow of said decedent is the same and identical person as the Louise Reinhold who executed a conveyance for said land to Carl B.
