This matter coming on regularly to be heard this 30th day of December, 1911, in Open Court, upon the application of Sadie M. King and Jessie Steffen, executors of the last will and testament of Edmund S. Newton, deceased, for an order to be herein made and entered declaring the estate of said decedent solvent; and it appearing to the Court at said hearing from the records and files herein and the evidence thereat adduced; That the last will and testament of said decedent herein duly filed, admitted to probate and recorded, names said Sadie M. King and Jessie Steffen, or the survivor of them, to be the executors or executrix thereof, and directs that no bond shall be required of them or either of them, as such, and authorizes and empowers said executors or executrix to administer upon, manage, settle, sell and convey said estate as to them may seem best without the necessity of Letters Testamentary or of Administration, and free from the intervention, supervision, or order or control of any Court whatsoever, except as by law required; that said Sadie M. King and Jessie Steffen have each and both duly qualified as executors of said will and Letters Testamentary have been duly issued to them without requiring any bond of them or either of them herein; that notice to the creditors of said decedent to present their claims has been duly published according to law and the order of the Court herein for five successive weeks in the Puyallup Valley Tribune, a newspaper published and of general circulation in Pierce County, State of Washington the date of the first publication of said notice being on November, 5th, 1911, proof of which said publication has been

herein duly filed; that due notice of the time and place of the appraisement: filed; that due notice of the time and place of the appraisement of said estate was duly served on the State Board of Tax Commissioners of the State of Washington, as by law required; that the inventory and appraisement of said estate has been duly made and filed herein and in and by the same it is shown and appears that said decedent left estate in Pierce County, State of Washington, consisting of real and personal property of the value of Eleven thousand fifty-six (\$11,056.00) Dollars, all of which the Court finds to have been the sole and separate estate of said decedent that, in addition to such sum, claim and charge as may be a lien upon said estate as an inheritance tax thereon under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Washington, all of the claims and charges against said decedent or his ^{said} estate, known to said executors, amount to but Three hundred fifty six and 25/100 Dollars, and that said estate is solvent and consists of more than sufficient property within the jurisdiction of this Court to pay all just claims against the same:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT: That the said Estate of Edmund S. Newton, deceased, be and the same is hereby declared to be solvent; and that said estate may be hereafter administered upon, managed, settled, sold and conveyed by said executors, Sadie M. King and Jessie Steffen, or the survivor of them, as in and by said will authorized, empowered and provided, without ~~without~~ further intervention, supervision, order or control of any Court whatsoever.
