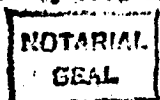
That I was acquainted with Charles H. Lewis grantee in the Warranty Deed recorded in Deed Record 32, page 320 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, conveying the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 29-74-28, and know of my own personal knowledge that said Charles H. Lewis is the same and identical person as C.H. Lewis, grantor in the Warranty Deed recorded in Deed Record 42, page 346 of said records.

I further state that I was well and personally acquainted with William E. Berry who died on or about Oct. 29, 1909, and whose estate was probated in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, and I know of my own personal knowledge that he left Vernie E. Berry, his surviving widow, who afterwards intermarried with Clyde (or J. Clyde) Lewis, and Milo B. Berry, Herbert J. Berry, Ada F. Berry and Anna J.
