 sworn upon oath depose and say that I am now and have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa,  
 for more than 35 years last past. That I am well and personally acquainted with the follow-  
 ing named persons, to-wit: J.J.Lyons whose full name is John Johnson Lyons and with G.H.  
 Lyons whose full name is George Harvey Lyons; ~~XXX~~ the said J.J.Lyons and G.H.Lyons being  
 children and heirs at law of A.E.Lyons, deceased, whose estate was probated in the District  
 Court of Madison County, Iowa, as No. 2470, and who died seized of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 28-74-26,  
 that said G.H.Lyons died in the State of Missouri, more than eight years ago, leaving George  
 Percy Lyons and others as his children and heirs at law, and that said George Percy Lyons  
 has always lived in the State of Missouri. That the Judgment of record in Transcript Judg-  
 ment Docket 13, page 61 in the Office of the Clerk of the District Court of Madison County

I further state that I am in no way interested in the title to the land herein described, but make this affidavit at the request of T.N.
