Browne, Grantee in the Warranty Deed recorded in Town Lot Deed Record 23, page 187, of the Records of Madison County, Iowa, wherein he acquired Title to the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot 6, Mill Addition to the City of Winterset, Madison County, Iowa, and know of my own personal knowledge that the personal tax of J.K. Browne shown unpaid in the delinquent personal tax record in the Office of the Treasurer of Madison County, Iowa, for the year 1919, assessed in South Township in the sum of \$3.18, is not an unpaid tax of the said J.K.
