State of Iowa, Madison County, ss: I, Rettie Fosher of said County and State being first duly sworn upon oath depose and say that I am the same and identical person as Rettie Fosher named as one of the grantors in the Warranty Deed dated February 23, 1889, filed for record February 28, 1889, recorded in Deed Record 27, page 233 of the records of Madison County Iowa, by which deed Samuel Fosher (who was my husband) and I conveyed the W¹/₂ SE¹/₄ of Sec. 33-76-28, Madison County, Iowa to Esther E.
